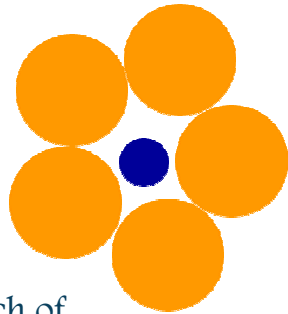


Decision Traps
